During my three years as a Councillor, my understanding of how issues can be tackled at District, Town and County level has grown. We've at last seen 'green issues' being taken more seriously and Greens on the District Council have had a major impact on the Environment strategy. We need to be there to ensure the Council delivers on that and more.

Green issues are relevant to most aspects of everyday life: how we live and enjoy our lives with respect for our immediate and greater environment. Dear Voter,

For the last three years I have represented the Valley Ward as your Green Councillor and I would like to continue.

These are the issues I believe in most strongly and have been working on:

- ✓ Safe streets for children and all – I organised a conference at Ebley Mill on Shared Spaces, have persuaded the Glos County Council to hold a conference on Shared Spaces and have undertaken a tour of Holland for engineers and councillors to see how they do it.
- ✓ Energy Efficiency in homes – I generate part of my home's electricity requirement, and it's more efficient to grant aid local production than build nuclear power stations. I have pushed for the District Council to provide renewable energy generation where it has funded affordable homes.
- ✓ Green spaces – Stroud and in particular Valley ward needs more open green spaces; our streams and brooks should be accessible and not culverted or hidden behind railings. I have pushed to preserve and enhance these throughout the ward, for example Summer Crescent community space.
- ✓ Local Food production: I support the Farmers' Market and am a member of the community assisted agriculture association.
- ✓ Aston Down (development of Minchinhampton Common) – I commissioned a comprehensive Green Party paper on development at Aston Down, the recommendations of which are now Council policy.
- ✓ Other issues I have been working on include the Scrutiny committee, CO2 reduction, waste reduction and re-use, setting up 'Cycle Sundays' and bio-diversity. I enjoy taking risks and asking difficult questions. I will do my best to make Stroud a better, safer and open place.
