

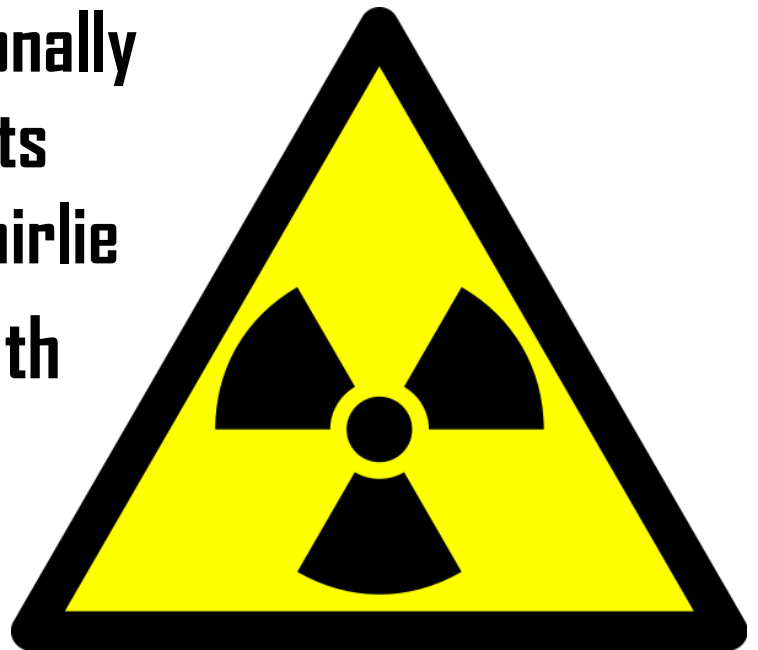

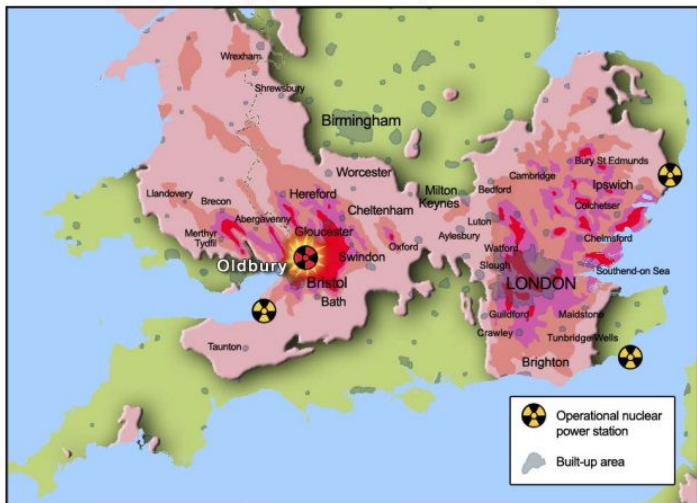

## HOW SAFE IS OLDBURY NUCLEAR POWER STATION?

At Oldbury, just 15 miles from Stroud, the oldest nuclear power station in the country has just been restarted. Following repeated shutdowns for safety tests the new safety system recommended by the Nuclear Inspectorate has not been installed. Yet the reactor is now operating for what appears to be purely economic reasons. Top nuclear expert John Large described the continued use of Oldbury as “deeply alarming”... come and hear him explain why.
